Cancer screening camp held on 01st JULY 2026.

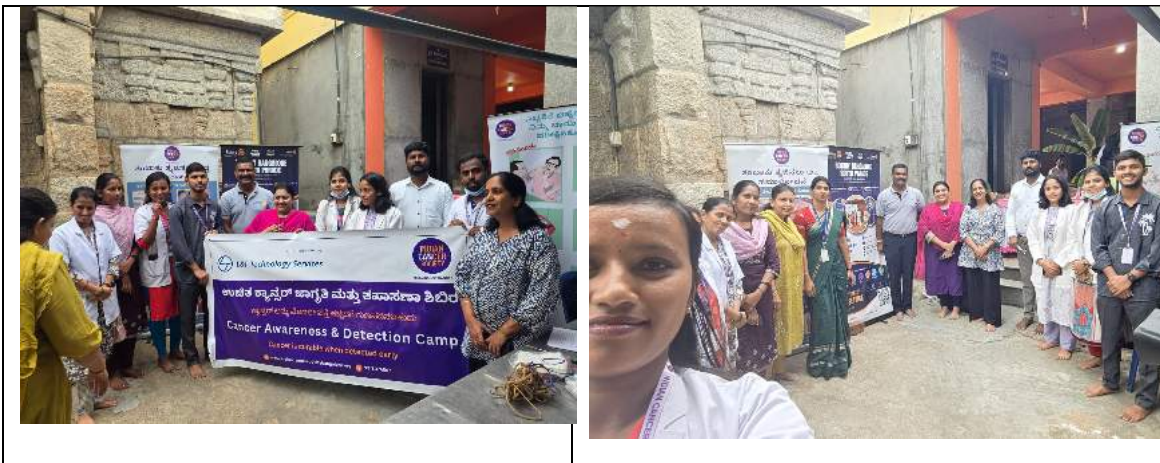
A New Beginning. A New Term. A Greater Purpose

Rotary Bangalore South Parade proudly launched the new Rotary term on 01st July 2026 by hosting our first Cancer Awareness & Detection Camp on the occasion of National Doctors' Day at Harohalli.

There could not have been a more profound way to kick off our year than by serving the community through preventative health, early detection, and hope. In collaboration with the Indian Cancer Society, our team screened 100 local residents (62 women and 38 men).

Through specialized screenings, including oral checks, breast scans, and HPV cervical cancer tests, we identified 4 high-risk clinical suspects. They are now being supported by Rotary for immediate medical follow-up. Early detection saves lives, and our members are proud to step forward as People of Action.

A special thank you to our Community Service Director Rtn. Vaibhavi, and volunteers Rtn. Somshekar and Rtn. Uma for their active participation in the program.

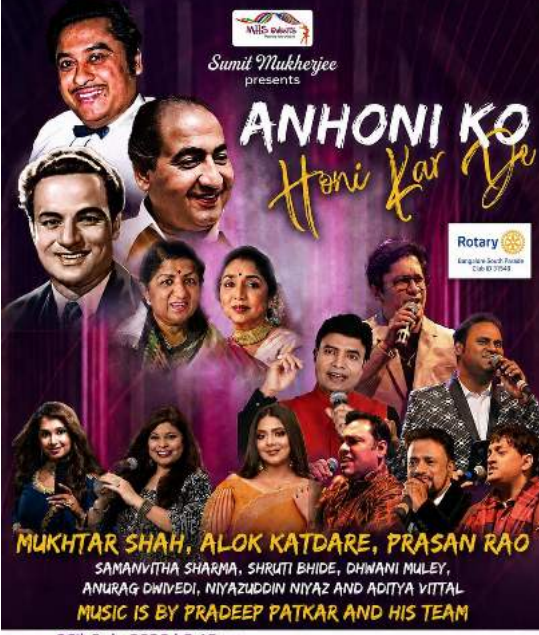


Music events at Chowdiah memorial hall held on 26th JULY 2026.
